

SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTIONS (STI) FAQS

“Talk. Test. Treat.” (OHA with CDC, 2023)

01. What are STIs? Infections spread through vaginal, anal, and oral sex.

02. What are some symptoms of STIs? Sores on mouth, genitals, rectal areas, hands, feet, or torso. Burning or pain during urination or sex. Penile or vaginal discharge. Swelling of your groin glands.

03. How are STIs spread? Sexual contact with someone who has an STI. From the birthing woman to baby during pregnancy/delivery. Sharing needles when injecting drugs or other substances.

04. How do I get tested? By a health care provider, local health department, or school or community clinic.
